It is with great humility and optimism that I present to you the current state of affairs of the Local NUGS Secretariat, highlighting key activities and impact engagements undertaken in our first semester.

**Our vision has been clear: to serve students with purpose, as a proud stakeholder to the SRC and school management to contribute to the development of the school.**

### KEY HIGHLIGHTS:

#### 1. Student Engagement:

Through our Local NUGS Talk, we engaged new and continuing students, introducing them to the vision, benefits, and operations of NUGS. This initiative helped lay a strong foundation for student involvement throughout the semester.

#### 2. National Representation:

On January 18th, we had the honor of representing UEW at the NUGS Central Committee (CC) Meeting hosted at the University of Cape Coast. This engagement allowed us to contribute to national student leadership discussions and build connections that benefit our local operations.

#### 3. Update on Documentation Services:

Despite receiving a directive from the Office of the Dean of Students to halt all documentation-related services (e.g., passport processing), we remain in active dialogue with the Dean's office. We are exploring the possibility of reinstating services such as driving license processing and others that directly benefit students, excluding passport acquisition for now.

#### 4. Student Loan Assistance:

Through a cooperative effort with the Student Loan Office, over 1,000 students have received the support they need to access financial aid out of the 5,669 beneficiaries SLTF has disbursed funds to.

#### 5. Empowering Women, Empowering Change:

The Power Conference was held on February 21, 2025 led by our Women's Commission.
